Children's Service Advisors up to £55k + 3 SPA points

These front line positions will provide advice, guidance and support to the Local Area Partnerships (LAPs) with specific responsibilities for the following areas: (i) 0- 8, (ii) 14-19 years, (iii) National strategies, and (iv) SEN and Inclusion. Working closely with School Improvement Partner(s), you'll take the lead in improving school performances within your area of expertise in line with local and national initiatives through the ECM agenda. Each role will be allocated an additional responsibility that may include CPD, diversity and achievement, NQTS and GTPs, EOTAS, BSF and Academies or other key agenda.

Head of SEN / Inclusion c. £55k + 3 SPA points

In this pivotal role, you'll formulate and plan our SEN and inclusion provision in response to the needs of local children and young people. As the Authority's specialist, you'll contribute fully to our strategy for improving the outcomes for children and young people in the area of inclusion and SEN in line with the wider ECM principles. Reporting directly to the Deputy Director, Learning, you'll work across Council departments and outside agencies, including voluntary and private sectors, providing specialist training and advice.

Head of Learner Support up to £47k + 3 SPA points

This is a key management role, which reports to the Head of SEN / Inclusion. You'll deliver, monitor and evaluate a broad range of specialist access and inclusion services. Your ultimate responsibility is to promote and influence behaviour, reduce truancy and improve attendance and reduce exclusions in schools, producing tangible results and outcomes in line with the principles of ECM. To achieve this, your role is to promote the Local Area Partnerships (LAPs) and develop a 'joined up' and truly multi-agency approach.
